Coronavirus (COVID 19) Vaccination Requirement

Children's Health is requiring all team members, practitioners, volunteers, students/trainees, as well as vendors and contractors to receive the COVID-19 vaccine and be fully vaccinated by Friday, Oct. 1, 2021. This decision aligns with actions being taken by many other health systems in our community and across the country. We made this decision to protect all those who contribute and provide care on our campuses, so they are available when their skills and talents are needed most, as well as part of our collective duty and privilege in caring for this region's most vulnerable, medically complex patient population.

Similar to our flu vaccine protocol, the COVID-19 vaccine is required as a condition of employment or a condition of delivering care and support to the patients we serve, and those who are unvaccinated will have until Friday, Oct. 1, 2021, to comply.

Here is what you need to know:

- Individuals will be considered "fully vaccinated" when they have received both doses of either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine or the one-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
- This is a requirement, and individuals will be prohibited from providing services on Children's Health facilities if you fail to comply.

To comply with this requirement, the student will need to sign this form and submit it with the rest of their paperwork. Please reach out to Student Services with any questions.

STUDENT ATTESTATION

I understand that Children's Health is requiring all team members, practitioners, volunteers, students/trainees, as well as vendors and contractors to receive the COVID-19 vaccine and be fully vaccinated by Friday, Oct. 1, 2021.
